

How can I register with mydlink on my DIR-845L

Step 1: Log into you device using it's IP address, for example:

Step 2: Click on "SETUP"



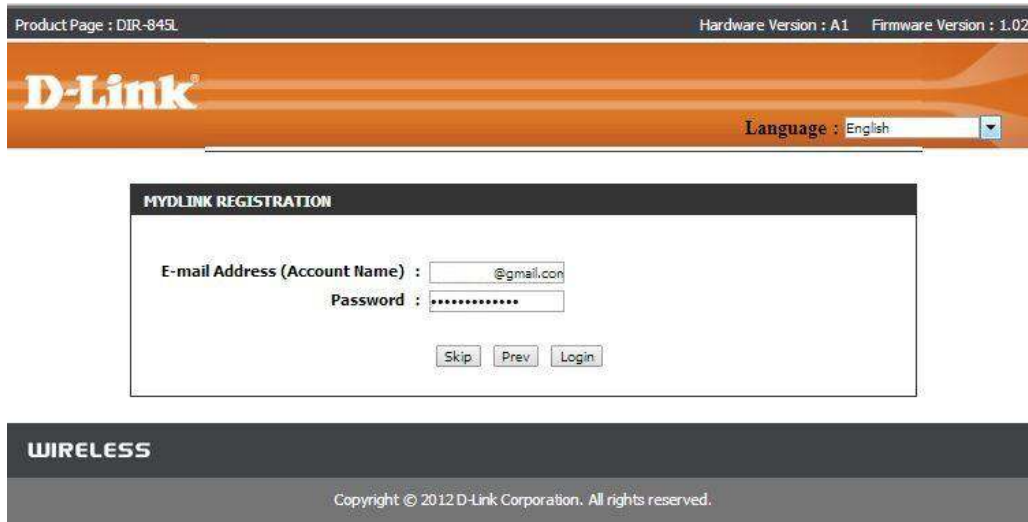
Step 5: Here you will be presented with **two options** based upon the following question:

Step 6: Click on **“Yes, I have mydlink account”**

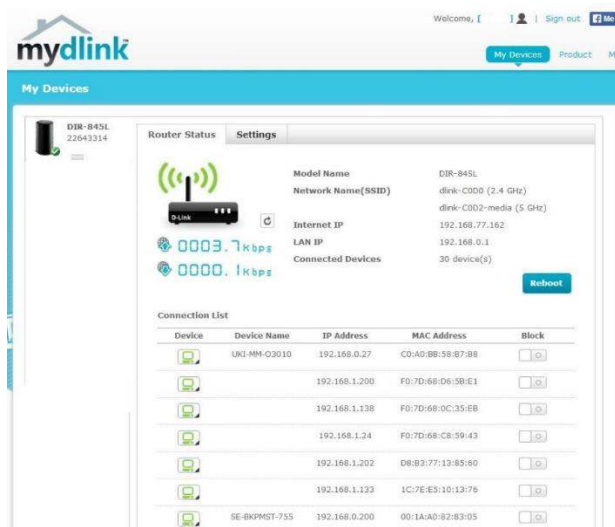


Enter the following details:

Once logged in, accept any messages which may popup, such as JAVA.

Click inside the box “I accept the mydlink terms and conditions”, then click on “Sign up”

Step 8: You should receive the following messages



Please check the account you have used for confirmation instructions

Click on “Aceptar”



You will now be presented with the above message. Click on "Aceptar"

Step 9: You can finally check by clicking on SETUP – MYDLINK SETTINGS



You will now see "Registered" and an email address present. Due to the device has been registered to the email you have selected, the "**Reister mydlink Service**" will be greyed out.
