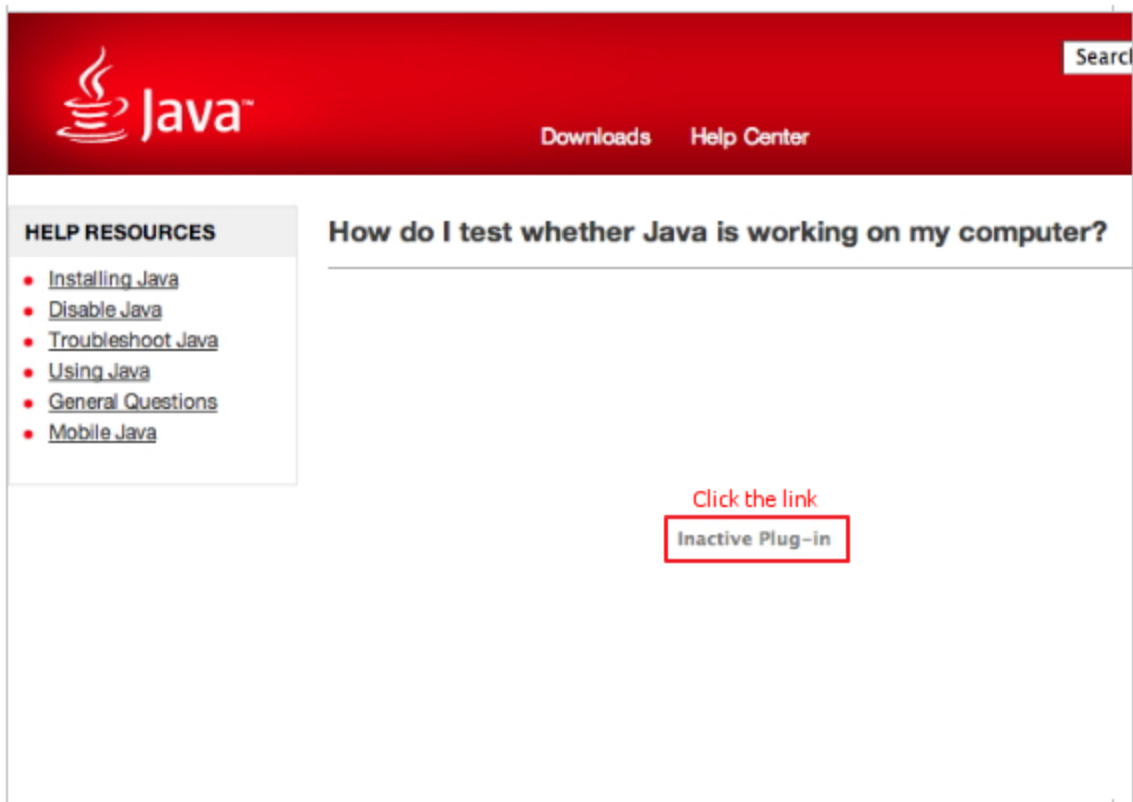


Step 1: Go to Safari -> Preference -> Security, **Enable plug-ins/Enable Java/Enable JavaScript**
